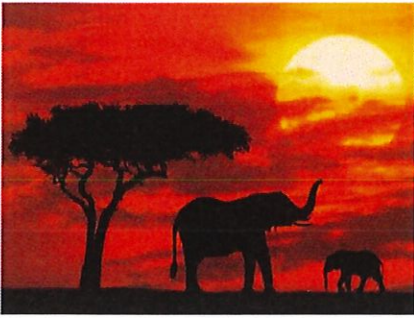


Hearthstone ELC Newsletter – February 2019
