

Dining, Activities, and Off-Campus Trips

CONGREGATE DINING

- ✓ Residents **can** participate in congregate dining:
 - if fully vaccinated and may participate without masking or physical distancing.
 - if unvaccinated but must keep mask on when not eating and must physical distance.
 - if vaccination status is unknown but must keep mask on when not eating and must physical distance.
- ✓ Residents **cannot** participate in congregate dining:
 - if they have a COVID-19 infection, are in isolation or quarantine, or are suspected of being positive for COVID-19, regardless of vaccination status.
- ✓ Cloth face masks must be worn to and from the dining room.
- ✓ Staff must perform hand hygiene and change PPE as appropriate in between assisting residents.

BEAUTY SHOP

- ✓ Hand-held dryers may be used if both the hairdresser and resident are vaccinated.
- ✓ No residents in isolation or quarantine may enter the beauty shop.

GROUP ACTIVITIES

- ✓ Only residents **not** in isolation or quarantine may participate in group activities.
- ✓ If all residents participating in group activities are fully vaccinated, they may remove their masks and chose to have close contact.
- ✓ If unvaccinated residents are present, all residents must wear masks and physical distance.
- ✓ Avoid sing-alongs and vocal performances.

OFF-CAMPUS TRIPS

- ✓ If any unvaccinated residents are on the vehicle, limit transportation occupancy based on six feet of separation is required and masks must be worn.
- ✓ If all residents are vaccinated, no masks are required and physical distancing is not required. All other vehicle transportation rules apply.
- ✓ Upon return from a trip outside the facility:
 - unvaccinated residents that spend overnight out of the building must be placed in transmission-based precautions for 14 days.
 - fully vaccinated residents do not have to quarantine.
 - residents within 90 days of a confirmed COVID-19 infection do not need to quarantine.
